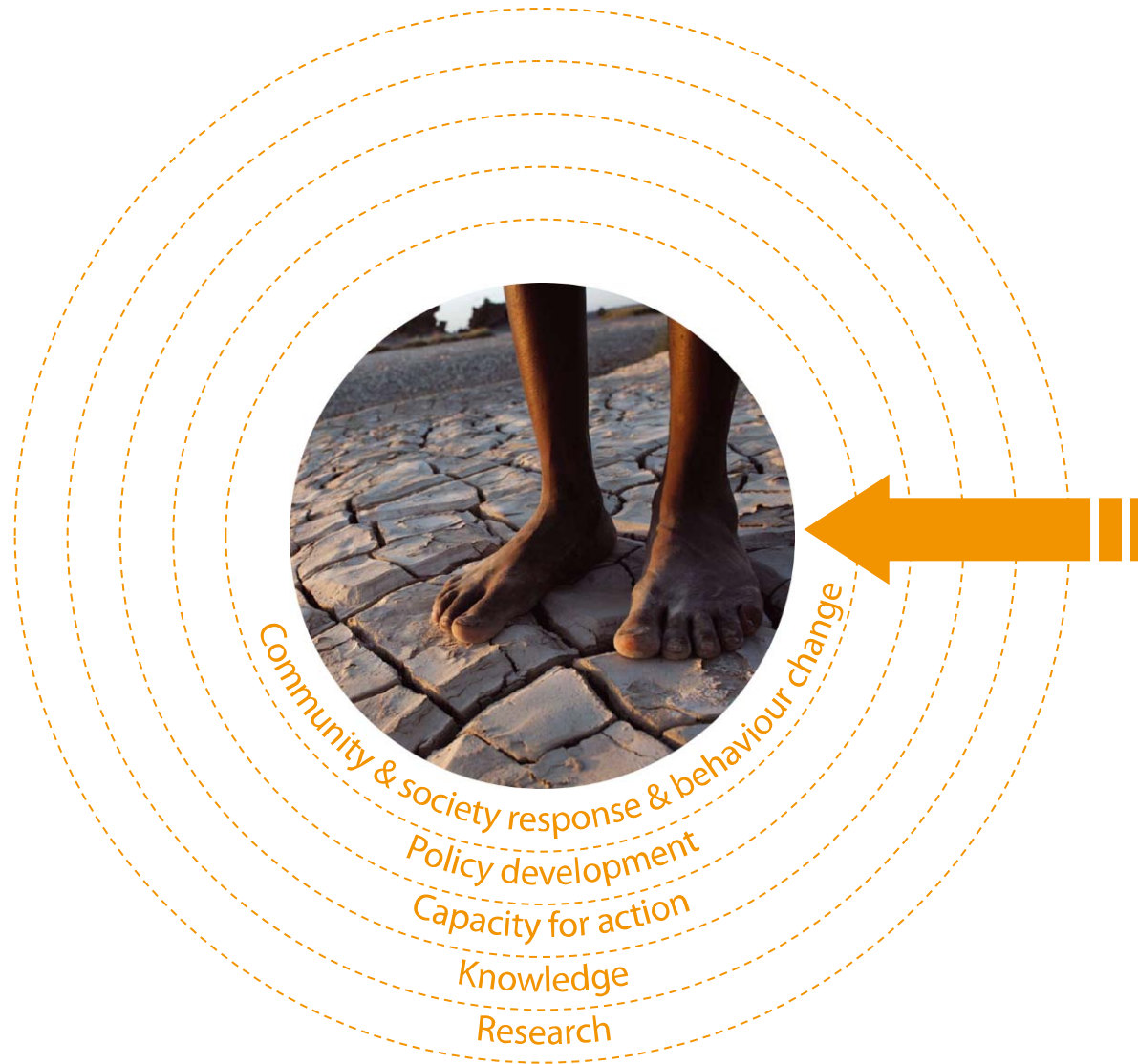

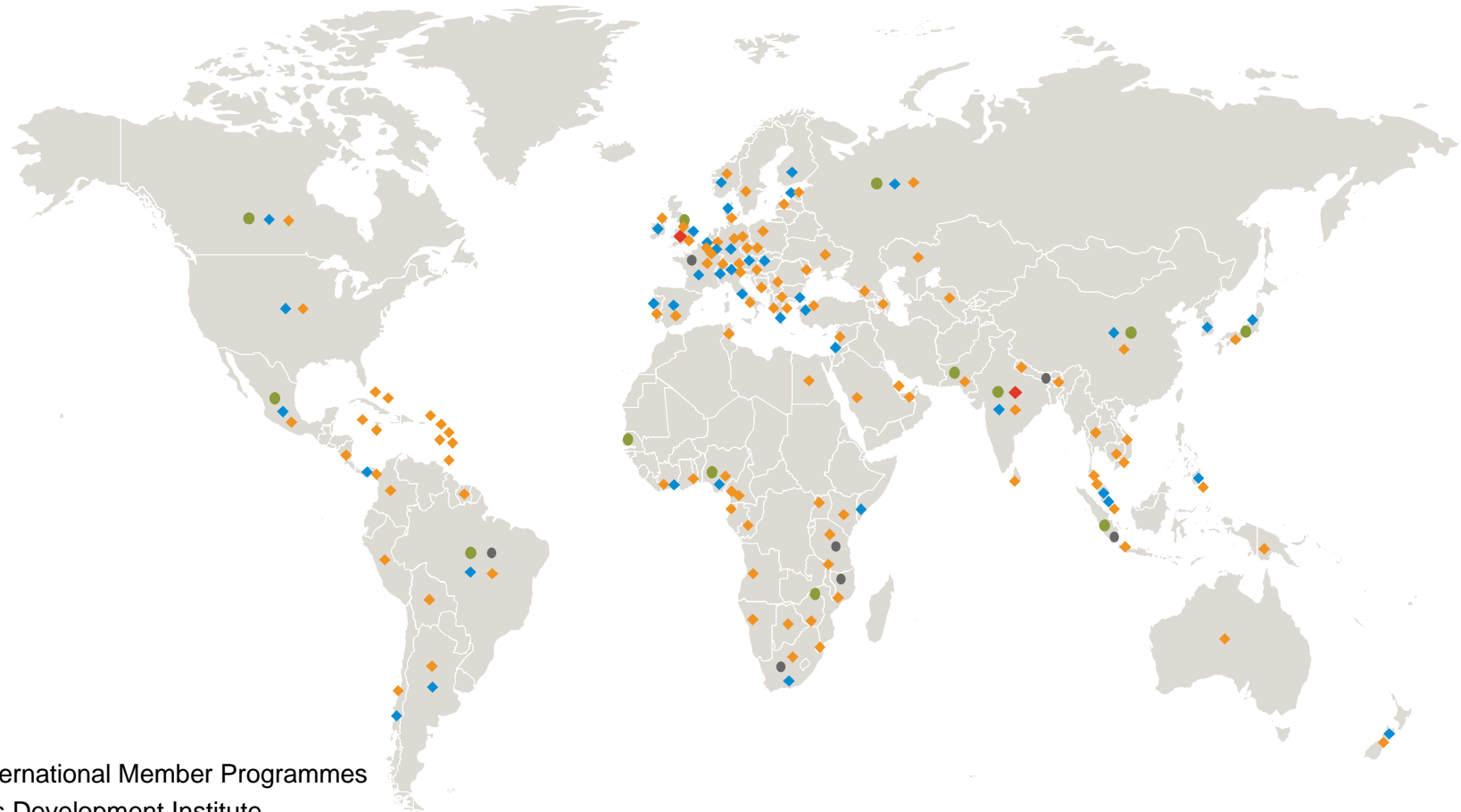

# Technical Assistance Activities

1. **Strengthening the Institutional Framework to coordinate climate change**
  - E.g. Support in formulating a National Climate Change Strategy
2. **Climate change impacts and adaptation information for decision-making**
  - E.g. Country-relevant climate variability data and climate change scenarios
3. **Adaptation strategy advice and economic analysis**
  - E.g. Support assessment and development of regulatory frameworks / interventions for adaptation across sectors (such as water, transport, energy, agriculture, health, trade and business)
4. **Implications of carbon markets and GHG regulations**
  - E.g. Economic analysis of mitigation options/priorities related to regulatory intervention
5. **Scaling up low carbon energy and technology solutions**
  - E.g. Carbon reduction strategies and implementation plans for government departments and agencies, infrastructure and services, business sectors, regions and communities
6. **Developing forestry, ecosystems and land-use strategies and programs**
  - E.g. Country preparedness analysis for emerging forest global REDD initiatives
7. **Accessing and leveraging climate finance**
  - E.g. Analysis of relevant existing and emerging (donor) climate financing options for country strategies, plans, programs
