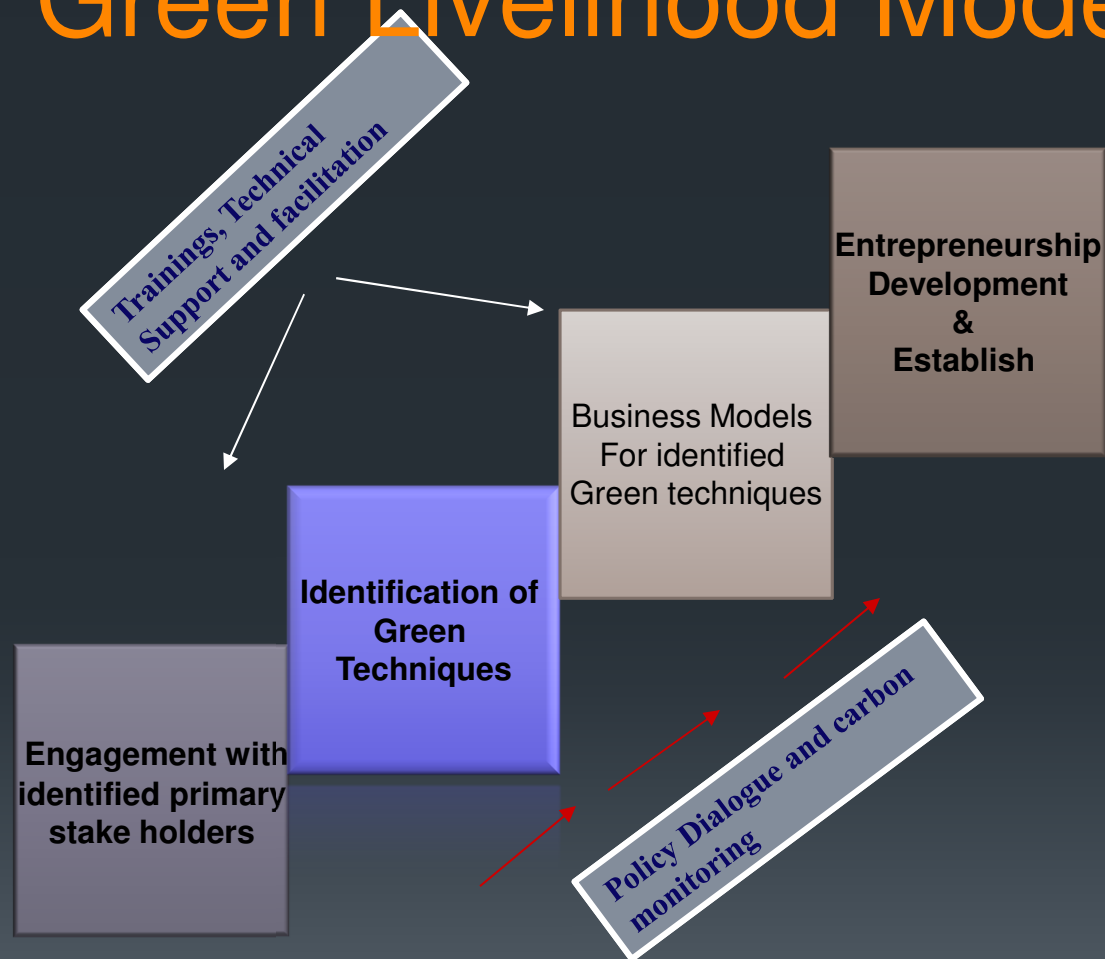


Capacity Building & Training-Approach
