

 - Multi-sector synthesis

Challenges for Asia, Chapter 24

- □ Increasing policy relevant research in critical sectors nexus of water/agriculture/health; economics aspects in increasing resilience / etc.;
- Building capacity on framing adaptation challenges (context is critical); identifying suitable entry points; balancing academic rigour and user applicability (method and tools).
- □ Promoting genuine practitioner/<u>university</u>/government partnerships (e.g. AUEDM, APAN)
- Building capacity of practitioners and researchers to increase contribution to peer reviewed literature


Number of journals on Asia, 2007-2010
