6th International Symposium on Climate Change Adaptation

8 July 2014 | Songdo, Republic of Korea

BACKGROUND

The Asia Pacific Adaptation Network, jointly with the Korea Adaptation Center for Climate Change under the Korea Environment Institute, organised the 6th International Symposium on Climate Change Adaptation on 8 July 2014 in Songdo, Republic of Korea. The symposium was hosted by the Ministry of Environment of Korea.

This one-day event brought together over 200 international and national adaptation experts, policy-makers, researchers, practitioners, and media.

The symposium was designed based on the current context of adaptation: (i) Adaptation needs have increased as climate change risks grow with global temperature rise; (ii) Adaptation, a relatively new concept, requires knowledge sharing as research is still insufficient and uncertainty is high; and (iii) Adaptation, required at all levels at all times, has diverse stakeholders and they must be meaningfully included in adaptation discussions.

OBJECTIVE

The symposium aimed to raise awareness, promote sharing and dissemination of adaptation knowledge, and contribute to enhancing adaptive capacity of practitioners through sharing international and national good practices on climate change adaptation.

OUTCOMES

- Raised awareness regarding national efforts on climate adaptation in different countries.
- Enabled experience sharing and facilitated a discussion on lessons learnt from the perspective of adaptation experience and finance.
- Threw light on future directions for adaptation.

CONCLUSION

- What is required is top down and bottom up efforts to climate action to achieve the goal of climate change adaptation.
- Climate financing is of crucial importance to implement climate action
- It is imperative to build upon and work in partnership with different players including the government, development agencies, the private sector, and others.
